1 I recommend that Cabinet note this report on my travel to Melbourne, Australia, on 16 March 2023.

- 2 The purpose of the travel was to attend the Sub-Regional Meeting on Counterterrorism and Transnational Security.
- 3 The Fourth Sub-Regional Meeting on Counterterrorism and Transnational Security brought together Ministers from New Zealand, Australia, Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore and Thailand to discuss matters of security importance in the south east Asian region.
- 4 Attendees spoke about the regional security environment, the effect of foreign terrorist fighters returning to the region, and climate change changing the threat picture. They also spoke about the need for cooperation on cyber and critical infrastructure work, including sharing information on threats and building resilience to cyber-attacks across the region.
