## Panel discussion to air on Maori Television this weekend

A second CERA panel discussion will be televised this weekend, this time discussing insurance-related earthquake issues.

Representatives from IAG, Vero, AMI and the Insurance Council joined CERA chief executive Roger Sutton earlier this week to record the discussion.

The panel addressed a series of questions that were submitted by members of the public at CERA's community meetings over the past month.
