## Public Notice: Land Use Recovery Plan amendment to date of review and minor amendments

The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery, Hon Gerry Brownlee, has given approval for amendments to be made to the Land Use Recovery Plan extending the date of the Review from April 2015 to 30 September 2015 and to assist with interpretation of the Recovery Plan.

The approval was made under section 22 of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011 (CER Act) which allows the Minister to amend a recovery plan using a process the Minister considers appropriate including consultation with persons or organisations that were identified in the development of the draft Recovery Plan.

The Recovery Plan provides direction for residents, businesses and councils of greater Christchurch about where development should occur and what form it should take to support recovery.

The amendments and extension to the review were gazetted on 14 May, publically notified in The Press on 16 May and apply immediately.
