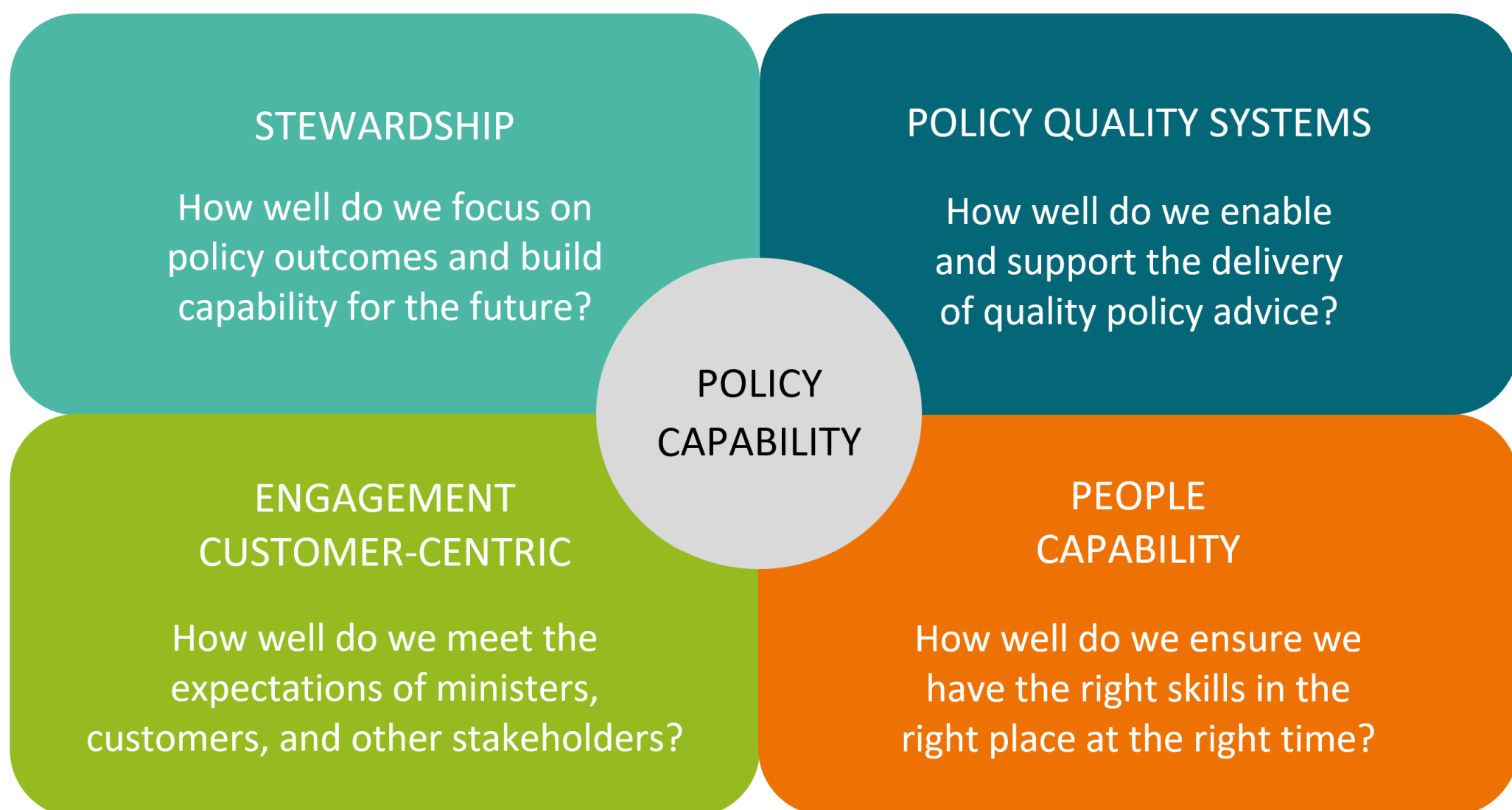


Policy Capability Framework



Policy agencies need to keep pace with current issues and invest in capability to meet future challenges. They need good systems for assuring policy quality, and to have skilled staff. They need to be adept at engaging with the decision-makers they are advising, as well as people likely to be affected by their advice. They need to be customer-centric.

The **Policy Capability Framework** enables policy agencies and teams to test their policy capability. It describes the key components of capability and offers 'lines of inquiry' and

potential indicators to review and build overall organisational capability to produce quality policy advice. A number of tools for reviewing agency capability against the framework are available.

This is one of three policy improvement frameworks co-designed for and by the policy community to help government agencies improve their policy quality and capability. It is supported by the Policy Skills Framework and the Policy Quality Framework.
