### Official Information Act request relating to Government Department Strategies

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request received on 15 January 2021. You requested:

*"OIA request (our reference 2021/07)*

*To clarify our official information request, we would like answers to the following four questions:*

- 1. Please list all GDSs that were archived in 2019/2020, being those that were in operation as at 31 December 2018 (see list attached) but are no longer in operation as at 31 December 2020? Please state the date (e.g., month and year) and the reason the strategy was archived.*
- 2. Please list GDSs that were moved to another department in 2019/20, being those that were in operation as at 31 December 2018 but is now being implemented by another government department as at 31 December 2020?*
- 3. Please list all new GDSs (published in 2019/2020) (being those that are not on the list as at 31 December 2018)?*
- 4. Please list all new GDS (published in 2019/2020) that have also been archived in 2019/20? I expect there will not be many of these."*

Please find below a table of departmental strategies and strategic documents for the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) and its departmental agency the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA), listed alphabetically.

I can confirm no strategies have been moved to another department, with the exception that NEMA assumed all functions and responsibilities of the Ministry of Civil Defence & Emergency Management from 1 December 2019.

Part 4 of your request refers to strategies that have been archived. Although DPMC do not use the term archived, as these documents are all still publicly available, I would note that *DPMC Strategic Intentions 2018-2022* (row 5 of the above table) was superseded in 2020. This may meet your definition of archived for the purposes of your request.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.

This response will be published on DPMC's website during our regular publication cycle. Typically, information is released monthly, or as otherwise determined. Your personal information including name and contact details will be removed for publication.
