GOVERNOR-GENERAL'S TRAVEL TO AUSTRALIA

Proposal

Cabinet is asked to note that the Governor-General, Her Excellency The Rt Hon Dame Patsy Reddy, will travel to Australia from 2 to 6 June 2021.

Summary

- At the invitation of the Prime Minister, the Governor-General undertakes a programme of international travel, representing New Zealand in the Head of State role (Cabinet Manual 2017, paragraph 1.13).
- The principal purpose of the visit is to resume reciprocal visits by Governors-General between New Zealand and Australia. This visit had originally been scheduled to take place in 2020, but was delayed by the COVID-19 response.
- The Governor-General will be accompanied on the visit by Sir David Gascoigne and three Government House staff (the Acting Official Secretary, a Communications Advisor, and an Aide-de-Camp) and two Protection Service officers.

Travel

The Governor-General and accompanying officials will travel to and from Australia on commercial flights. The itinerary does not include Victoria.

Financial implications

- The cost of the visit is approximatelys9(2)(f)(iv), for flights between Australia and New Zealand. s6(a)
- 7 The costs for the Governor-General and party will be met from the permanent legislative authority in Vote Prime Minister and Cabinet for the travel expenses of the Governor-General under section 14 of the Governor-General Act 2010.
- 8 The expenses of the Protection Service officers will be met from Vote Police.

Consultation

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade has been consulted in the development and implementation of the Governor-General's programme and this Cabinet paper.


Recommendations

It is recommended that Cabinet:

- note that the Governor-General will be absent from New Zealand from 2 to 6 June 2021 to undertake a visit to Australia;
- 2. **note** that the Governor-General will be accompanied by Sir David Gascoigne, the Acting Official Secretary, a Communications Advisor, and an Aide-de-Camp from Government House, and two Protection Service officers;
- 3. **note** that the total cost of the visit for the Governor-General's party from Government House to Australia will be approximately \$9(2)(f)(iv)
- 4. **note** that these costs will be met from the appropriation under permanent legislative authority in Vote Prime Minister and Cabinet for the travel expenses of the Governor-General under section 14 of the Governor-General Act 2010; however, the travel expenses of the two Protection Service officers will be met from Vote Police;
- 5. **note** that in the absence of the Governor-General from 2 to 6 June 2021 the Chief Justice, Rt Hon Dame Helen Winkelmann, will act as Administrator of the Government.

- noted that the Governor-General will be absent from New Zealand from 2 to 6 June 2021 to undertake a visit to Australia;
- 2 **noted** that the Governor-General will be accompanied by Sir David Gascoigne, the Acting Official Secretary, a Communications Advisor, and an Aide-de-Camp from Government House:
- noted that the total cost of the visit for the Governor-General's party will be approximately s9(2)(f)(iv) as a charge to Vote: Prime Minister and Cabinet;
- 4 **noted** that the Governor-General's party will be accompanied by two Diplomatic Protection Service officers, whose travel expenses will be met from Vote: Police;
- 5 **noted** that in the absence of the Governor-General, the Chief Justice, Rt Hon Dame Helen Winkelmann, will act as Administrator of the Government.
