REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE REVIEW PANEL

CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE (BUILDING ACT) ORDER 2011

- 1. On 26 August 2011 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the Canterbury Earthquake (Building Act) Order 2011 (version PCO 15391/4.0).
- 2. The Review Panel considered the letter from David Kelly of the Department of Building and Housing dated 23 August 2011. The Review Panel sought further information on 24 August 2011 seeking an explanation about the timing of proposed replacement Order. The Department of Building and Housing provided further information in correspondence (attached) dated 24 August 2011.
- 3. The Review Panel noted that the Order in Council replaces the Canterbury Earthquake (Building Act) Order 2010, which expires on 16 September 2011, and provides councils with additional powers to deal with dangerous building situations and extends the period for which the powers are available to 16 September 2013.
- 4. The Review Panel is of the view that the draft Order is necessary, expedient and meet the purposes of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

Recommendation

1. The Review Panel recommends to the Minister of Building and Construction that the Canterbury Earthquake (Building Act) Order 2011 (version PCO 15391/4.0) be made without change.
