#### REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE REVIEW PANEL

## CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE (TRANSPORT LEGISLATION-CANTERBURY REGIONAL TRANSPORT PLANNING) ORDER 2011

- 1. On 15 September 2011 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the Canterbury Earthquake (Transport Legislation-Canterbury Regional Transport Planning) Order 2011 (version PCO 15430/8.0).
- 2. The Review Panel considered the letter from Tony Frost of the Ministry of Transport dated 13 September 2011.
- 3. The Review Panel noted that the Order in Council will extend the deadlines for the Canterbury Regional Council to adopt a new regional public transport plan and a new Regional Land Transport Strategy. It will also make some changes to Canterbury's existing regional passenger transport plan to accommodate the changed circumstances for bus services as a result of the earthquakes.

4. The Review Panel is of the view that the draft Order is necessary, expedient and meet the purposes of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

### **Recommendation**

1. The Review Panel recommends to the Minister of Transport that the Canterbury Earthquake (Transport Legislation-Canterbury Regional Transport Planning) Order 2011 (version PCO 15430/8.0) be made without change.
