REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE REVIEW PANEL

Canterbury Earthquake (Rating Valuations Act - Waimakariri District Council)
Amendment Order 2012

- 1. On 21 September 2012 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the draft Canterbury Earthquake (Rating) Order 2012 (version PCO 16767/2.0).
- 2. The Review Panel considered the letter from Richard O'Reilly of Land Information New Zealand dated 20 September 2012.
- 3. The Review Panel noted that the draft Order modifies the Canterbury Earthquake (Rating Valuations Act Waimakariri District Council) Order 2011 (2011 Order) to extend:
 - a. its expiry date and the application of provisions for district valuation roll maintenance and objections to 31 March 2015 at the latest; and
 - b. the effective date of the next general revaluation to on or before 1 December 2014.

- 4. The Review Panel notes that deferring the general revaluation will maintain the rating valuation system's operability, integrity and transparency, and facilitate a smooth return to the standard rating valuation system.
- 5. The Review Panel is of the view that the draft Order is necessary, expedient and meets the purposes of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

Recommendation

1. The Review Panel recommends to the Minister of Land Information and the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery that the Canterbury Earthquake (Rating) Order 2012 (version PCO 16767/2.0) be made without change.
