REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE REVIEW PANEL

CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE (CANTERBURY DISTRICT HEALTH BOARD LAND EXCHANGE) ORDER 2014

- 1. On 16 January 2014 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the Canterbury Earthquake (Canterbury District Health Board Land Exchange) Order 2014.
- 2. The Review Panel considered the letter from Michael Hundleby, Acting National Director, National Health Board.
- 3. The Review Panel noted that the process followed by officials is robust, extensive consultation has been held, and amendments have been made as a result. The parties holding significant interests and rights in these areas all support the proposal. The draft Order is in the best interests of Christchurch city and its wider community.
