REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE REVIEW PANEL

CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE (BUILDING ACT) ORDER 2013

- 1. On 9 September 2013 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the above draft Order (version PCO 17737/4.0).
- 2. The Review Panel considered the letter from Chris Bunny, General Manager, Construction and Housing Markets, the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment dated 9 September 2013 and noted that the objective of the proposals is to continue part of the Canterbury Earthquake (Building Act) Order 2011 to enable the existing dangerous building notices issued under the 2011 Order to continue in force.
- 3. The draft Order should meet the following objectives:
 - a. Protect the health and safety of building users in greater Christchurch and
 - b. Facilitate aspects of the wider response and recovery effort after the Canterbury earthquakes.
- 4. The Review Panel is of the view that the draft Order is necessary, expedient and meets the purposes of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

5. The Review Panel recommends to the Minister of Business and Construction that the Order be made.
