Public Notice: Amendment to the Christchurch District Plan

The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery, Hon Gerry Brownlee, has decided to amend the Christchurch City Plan to facilitate the continued development of the Kintyre Estates subdivision.

This decision was made pursuant to section 27(1)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011 (CER Act). The Minister considers the use of section 27(1)(a) of the CER Act is reasonably considered necessary and is in accordance with the purposes of the Act, specifically, to enable the timely provision of housing required for the recovery from the impacts of the Canterbury earthquakes.

The amendments were publicly notified in The Press and apply immediately. The Christchurch City Council is required to amend its District Plan accordingly.
