Approval was made under Section 27 of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011 (CER Act) to amend explanatory text in the Statement of Local Authority Responsibilities and the Principal reasons and explanation for Policy 11.3.1 of the Natural Hazards Chapter of the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement.

The Canterbury Regional Policy Statement sets out objectives, policies, methods, reasons and explanations to achieve integrated management of the natural and physical resources in Canterbury.
