Public Notice: Amendments to the Regional Policy Statement

Pursuant to section 27 (1)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011, the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery gives the following notice:

The Canterbury Regional Policy Statement is amended from the publication of this notice by:

- a. inserting the Introduction to Chapter 6 – Recovery and Rebuilding of Greater Christchurch
- b. inserting Issues 6.1.1, 6.1.2, 6.1.3, 6.1.4 and 6.1.5
- c. inserting the Explanation for Issues 6.1.1, 6.1.2, 6.1.3, 6.1.4 and 6.1.5
- d. inserting the Principal Reasons and Explanation for Objectives 6.2.1, 6.2.2, 6.2.3, 6.2.4, 6.2.5 and 6.2.6
- e. inserting the Principal Reasons and Explanation for Policies 6.3.1, 6.3.2, 6.3.3, 6.3.4, 6.3.5, 6.3.6, 6.3.7, 6.3.8, 6.3.9, 6.3.10, and 6.3.11
- f. inserting the Anticipated Environmental Results to Chapter 6 – Recovery and Rebuilding of Greater Christchurch
- g. inserting additional definitions into the Glossary and Definitions section of the Regional Policy Statement. Given the detailed material contained within these amendments, the full text is not provided in this public notice.

The effect of this notice is ancillary to the decision made under section 24(1)(a) of the CER Act to insert the objectives, policies and methods into Chapter 6 – Recovery and Rebuilding of Greater Christchurch. The inclusion of the parts of Chapter 6 – Recovery and Rebuilding of Greater Christchurch outlined above provide context and additional information necessary to understand and interpret the objectives, policies and methods. These insertions also bring the chapter in line and consistent with the rest of the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement and the requirements under the Resource Management Act 1991.
