

Corrigendum: Document *Public Notice:*Extension of Christchurch Clean Air Zone 1 and Kaiapoi Clean Air Zone 1 on the CERA Document Archive Website

9 June 2021

The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) has inserted this corrigendum to the document *Public Notice: Extension of Christchurch Clean Air Zone 1 and Kaiapoi Clean Air Zone 1* on the CERA Document Archive website in order to provide a correct documentary record for this material, as it was originally released in an incorrect form by the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Authority (CERA) on 27 April 2016.

Details of the Correction

The material describes a media release by CERA pertaining to a Public Notice issued on 15 May 2013 and originally announced on the cera.govt.nz and beehive.govt.nz websites on that date. The document comprises a short section of contextual information regarding the Public Notice, followed by the text of the notice itself. The Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet has become aware that the text of the notice is incorrect and pertains to a different notice issued on the same date (*Provisions to allow the installation and use of Ultra Low Emission Wood Burners*).

This corrigendum does not affect the contextual information and gives a replacement for the incorrect text of the public notice, which starts below the horizontal line on page 1 of the document following this corrigendum.

The correct text for the Public Notice is as follows:

The Public Notice

Pursuant to section 27(1)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011, the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery gives the following notice:

The Canterbury Natural Resources Regional Plan (2011) (NRRP) is amended from the publication of this notice by:

- (a) Inserting a new definition for "Christchurch Clean Air Zone 1" into Chapter 1;
- (b) Inserting a new definition for "Kaiapoi Clean Air Zone 1" into Chapter 1; and
- (c) Inserting a new definition for "Urban Residential Use" into Chapter 1.

Given the detailed material contained within these amendments, the full text is not provided in this public notice.

The effect of this notice is to amend the boundaries of Christchurch Clean Air Zone 1 and Kaiapoi Clean Air Zone 1 so that policies and rules in the NRRP aimed at managing air quality apply consistently to areas zoned for urban residential use, including to areas newly zoned from 11 June 2011 in the Christchurch City Plan and Waimakariri District Plan.

The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Gerry Brownlee has decided on amendments to the Canterbury Natural Resources Regional Plan (NRRP). These amendments will alter the boundaries of Christchurch Clean Air Zone 1 and Kaiapoi Clean Air Zone 1.

Provisions in the NRRP aimed at managing air quality now apply consistently to all areas in Christchurch and Kaiapoi zoned for urban residential use in the Christchurch City Plan and Waimakariri District Plan.

The amendments have now been publicly notified in The Press and apply immediately.

Pursuant to section 27(1)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011, the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery gives the following notice:

The Canterbury Natural Resources Regional Plan (2011) is amended from the publication of this notice by:

- (a) inserting new Policy AQL11A, to set emission standards for Ultra Low Emission Wood Burners;
- (b) inserting new Policy AQL13A to provide for the installation of Ultra Low Emission Wood Burners;
- (c) inserting new Rule AQL9B, AQL81B and AQL92A to provide for emissions to air from Ultra Low Emission Wood Burners as a restricted discretionary activity in Christchurch Clean Air Zone 1, Rangiora Clean Air Zone 1 and Kaiapoi Clean Air Zone 1 respectively; and
- (d) making consequential amendments to Policies AQL13, AQ23, AQL24, AQL25, AQL26, AQL31, AQL32, AQL33, AQL34, and adding the explanations and principle reasons for Rules AQL9B, AQL81B and AQL92A to section 3.5.

Given the detailed material contained within these amendments, the full text is not provided in this public notice.

The effect of this notice is to provide for the installation and use of Ultra Low Emission Wood Burners (ULEWBs) within Christchurch Clean Air Zone 1, Kaiapoi Clean Air Zone 1

This announcement was originally published on cera.govt.nz and beehive.govt.nz

and Rangiora Clean Air Zone 1. The amendment will allow for ULEWBs to be installed, as a restricted discretionary activity, in new and existing dwellings without a wood burner. ULEWBs may also be installed to replace existing, less efficient, wood burners.
