### **Public Notice: Land Use Recovery Plan - Commencement**

Pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011, the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery gives the following notice:

The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery has approved the Land Use Recovery Plan under section 21(2) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011, following amendments to the draft Land Use Recovery Plan.

The Land Use Recovery Plan sets out 50 Actions to support recovery and achieve the 15 outcomes of the Land Use Recovery Plan. These Actions are to address issues relating to: rebuilding communities, building new communities, providing for business, delivering infrastructure and services, natural hazards and environmental constraints, and implementing delivery mechanism for recovery.

Some Actions require changes to be made immediately to planning policy and rules in relevant RMA documents to provide for land use recovery. These changes are detailed in Volume 2 of the Land Use Recovery Plan. Other Actions require further work to be undertaken which will inform further changes to these documents. Some Actions record agreements between agencies to ensure recovery.

The Land Use Recovery Plan helps to give effect to the Recovery Strategy for Greater Christchurch: Mahere Haumanutanga o Waitaha and sits alongside the Christchurch Central Recovery Plan.

# The Land Use Recovery Plan is issued and comes into effect on 6 December 2013.
