Public Notice: Revocation of Proposed Change 1 to the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement

The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery, Hon Gerry Brownlee, has decided to revoke Proposed Change 1 to the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement.

This decision has been made pursuant to section 27 of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011, and means that Proposed Change 1 will no longer have effect. The decision is ancillary to the decision to insert the new Chapter 6 – Recovery and Rebuilding of Greater Christchurch into the Regional Policy Statement as a result of the approval of the Land Use Recovery Plan.

The amendments have now been publicly notified in The Press and apply immediately.

The public notice

Pursuant to section 27 (1)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011, the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery gives the following notice:

Proposed Change No 1 (Chapter 12A – Development of Greater Christchurch) to the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement (PC1) is revoked from the publication of this notice.

The effect of this notice is that Proposed Change 1 to the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement will no longer have effect.

This decision is ancillary to the decision of the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery made under section 24(1)(a) and section 27(1)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011 to insert a new Chapter 6 – Recovery and Rebuilding of Greater Christchurch, into the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement as result of the approval of the Land Use Recovery Plan.
