## Silverstream, West Kaiapoi

**Summary:** The Residential 7 Zone in West Kaiapoi provides for mixed residential development in an area known as Silverstream. It provides for a range of residential densities and housing styles (including a higher density area of an average of 200m2 allotments) designed as a comprehensive development subject to controls to avoid, remedy or mitigate adverse effects on amenity values. The comprehensive design includes recreational and amenity reserves.

The need for a higher level of density has arisen in part as a result of the Canterbury earthquakes in 2010 and 2011 and the displacement of households from the "red zoned" areas. Business 4 - West Kaiapoi provides for a small area of local community business activity.
