Results in this report are based on questions asked in three separate surveys:

Residents of Christchurch*	500	4.4%	31 st July – 1 st August
Nationwide **	750	3.6%	2 nd – 6 th August
Business owners/ managers***	400	4.9%	31 st July – 6 th August



"Generally speaking, are things in **Christchurch** heading in the right direction or are they off on the wrong track?"



"Are you aware of the recent announcement by the Government and Christchurch City Council about the rebuild of the Christchurch central city area?"






Knowledge of Christchurch rebuild




Support for Christchurch rebuild




Support for Christchurch rebuild – among those who know 'a lot' or 'a fair amount'

Christchurch residents

- Those who know about the plan (66%)
- Those who believe it is a good time to invest in Christchurch (64%)
- Professionals/ Managers (67%)
- High income earners

Christchurch businesses

- Those who want to locate their business to the new CBD area (87%)
- Those who know about the plan (82%)
- Those who believe it is a good time to invest in Christchurch (80%)

Nationwide

- Those living in the wider Christchurch area (71%)
- Those on higher incomes (60%)
- Note that Wellingtonions were more likely to support than Aucklanders (61% vs. 46% respectively)

- Those who support the plan (70%)
- Professionals/ Managers (74%)
- High income earners (73%)


Christchurch businesses

- Those who support the plan (78%)
- Those who want to locate their business to the new CBD area (77%)

Nationwide

- Those living in the wider Christchurch area (78%)
- Those on high incomes (63%)

- Those who think that is is a good time to invest (93%)
- Those who support the plan (92%)
- Those aged 45+ (93%)

Christchurch businesses

 Almost unanimous agreement to stay in Christchurch (97%)


Nationwide

- Those residing in rural areas (94%)
- Middle income earners (92%)
- Those aged 45-59 years (91%)
- Those aged over 60 years (90%)

Christchurch businesses

Those in the Professional, Scientific and Technical Services more likely to prefer 'New CBD' (44%) Those in the construction and manufacturing industries more likely to prefer 'elsewhere in greater Christchurch area' (76% and 83% respectively)
