

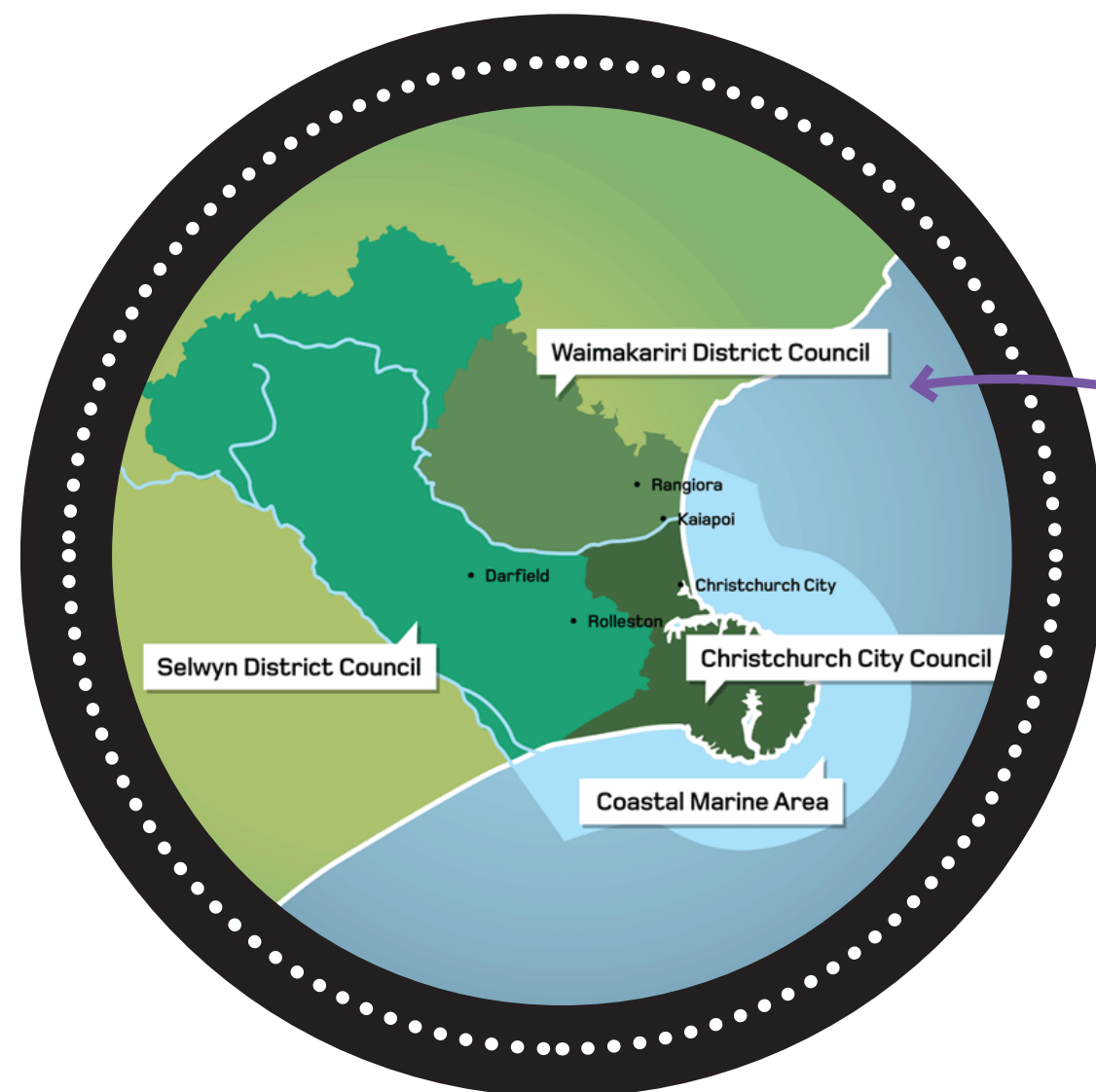

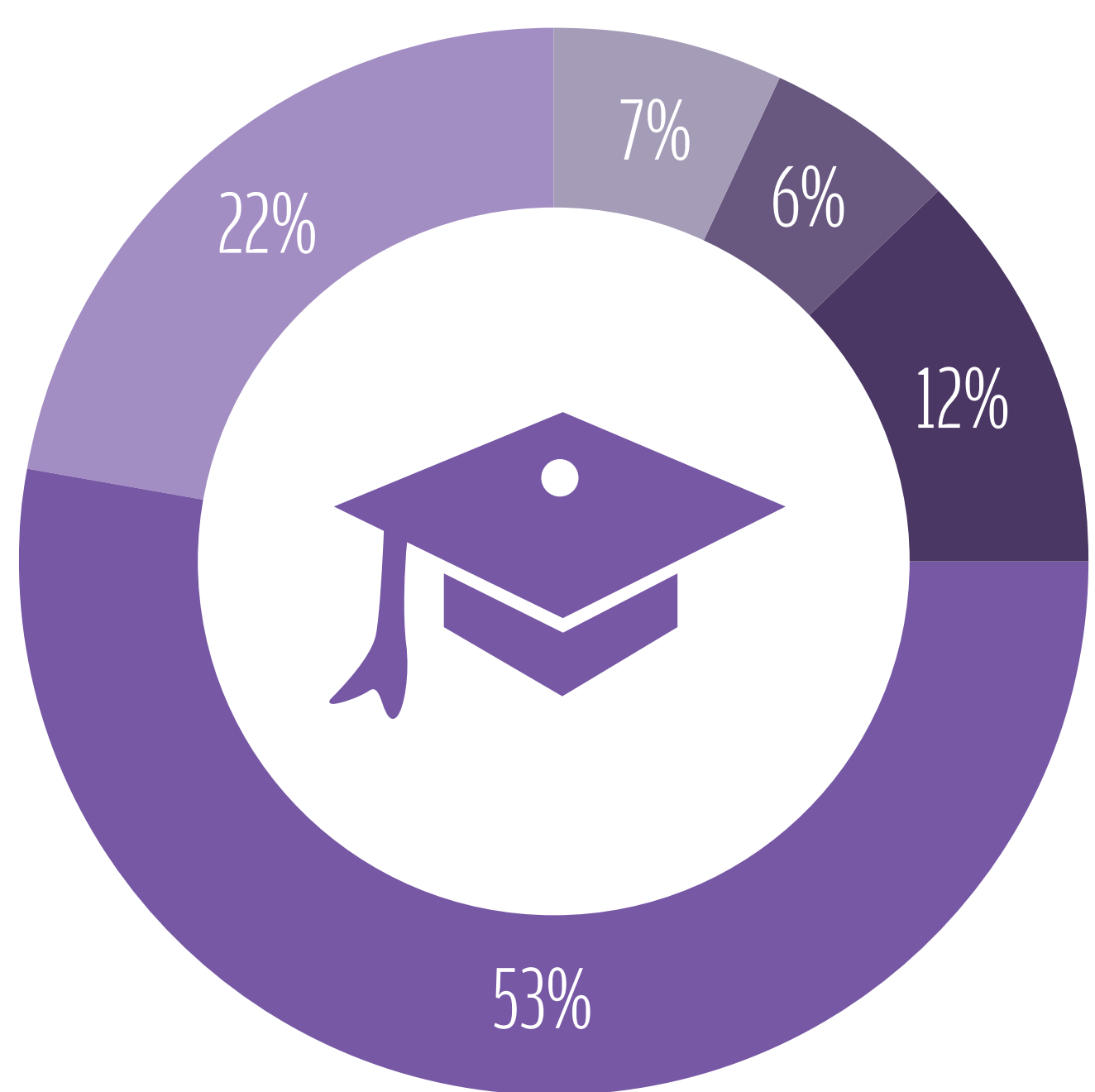
LOOKING AHEAD

Education and employment opportunities are big considerations when figuring out where you're going. We asked what you think your prospects are like in greater Christchurch and where you might find yourself in the coming years.

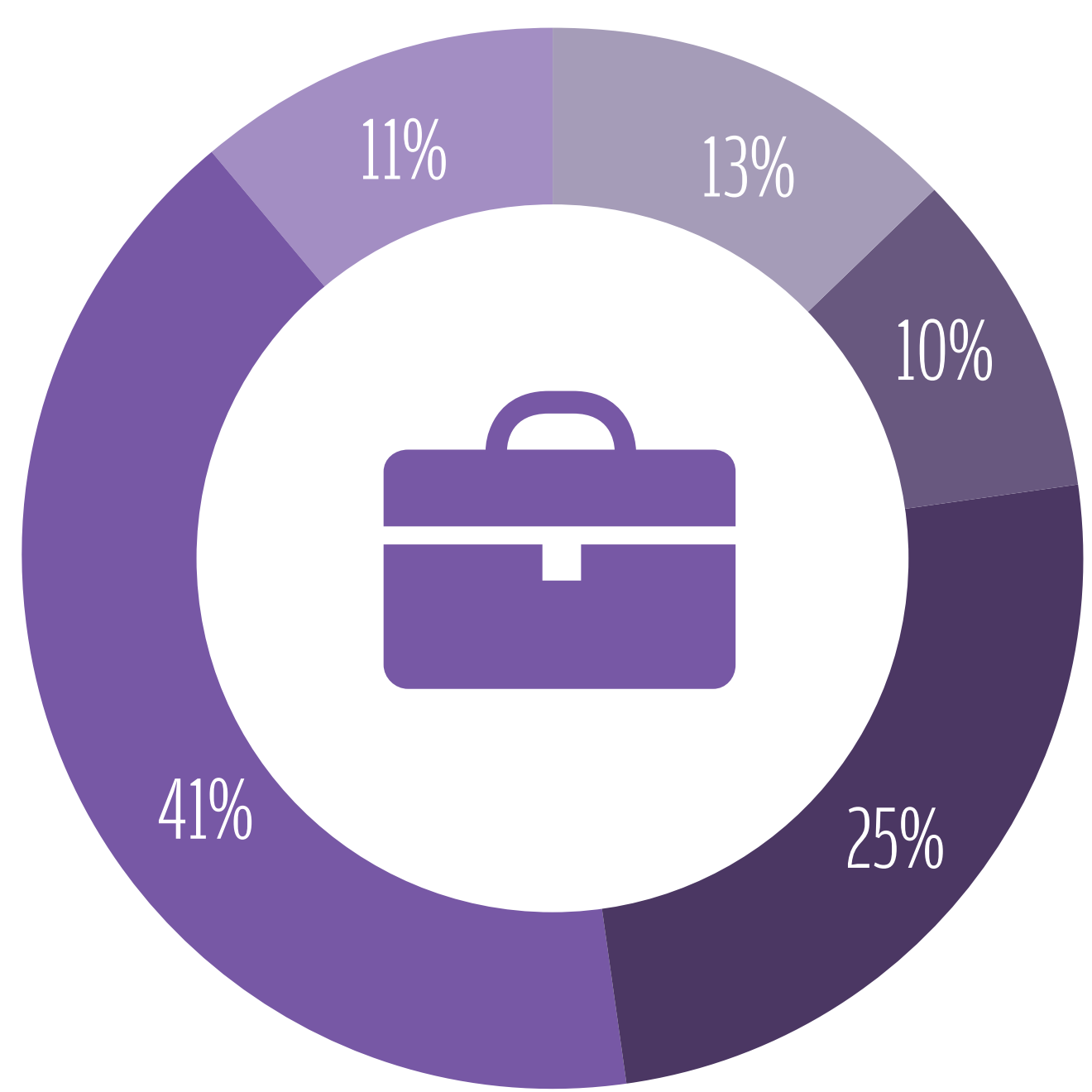

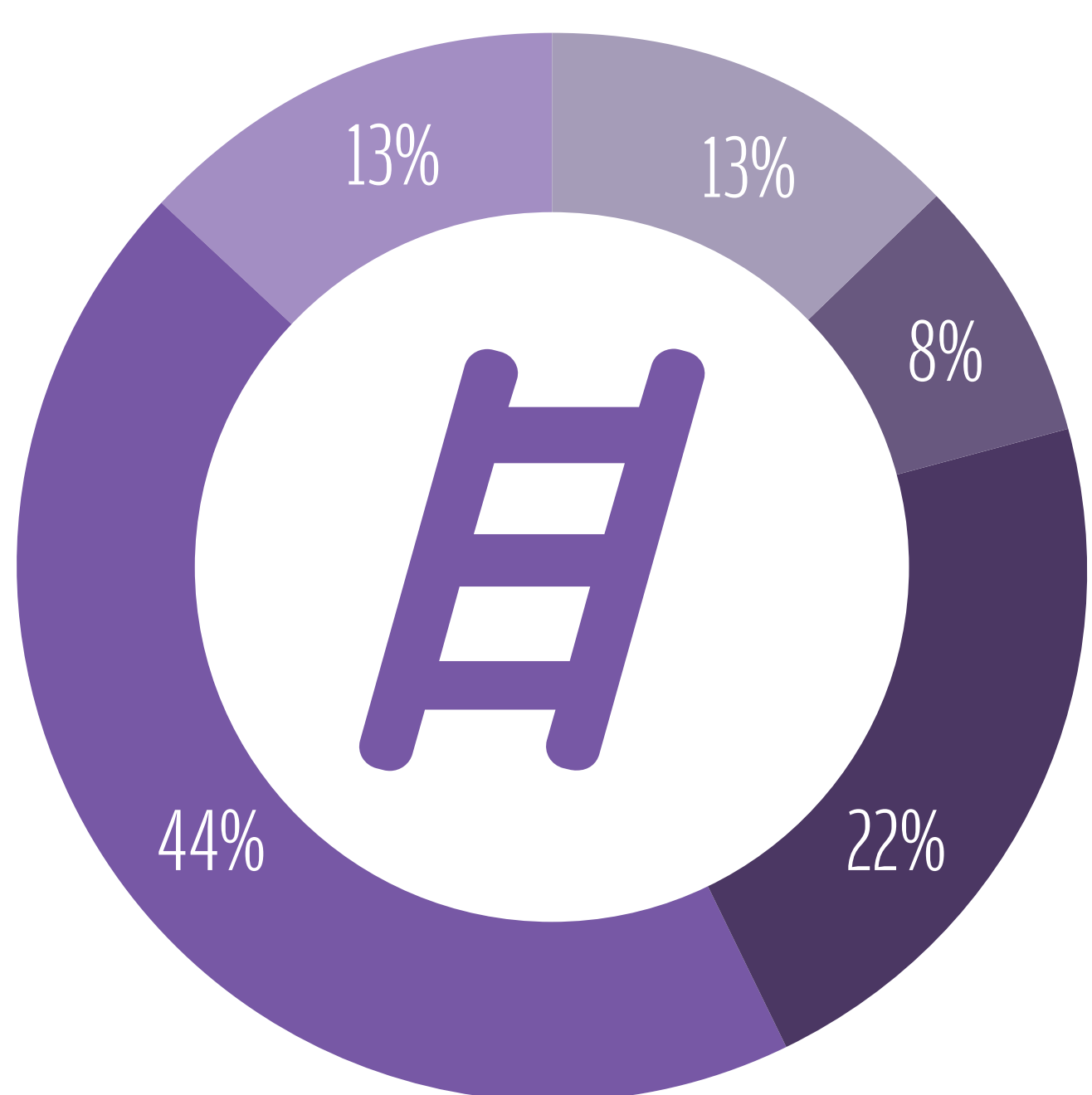

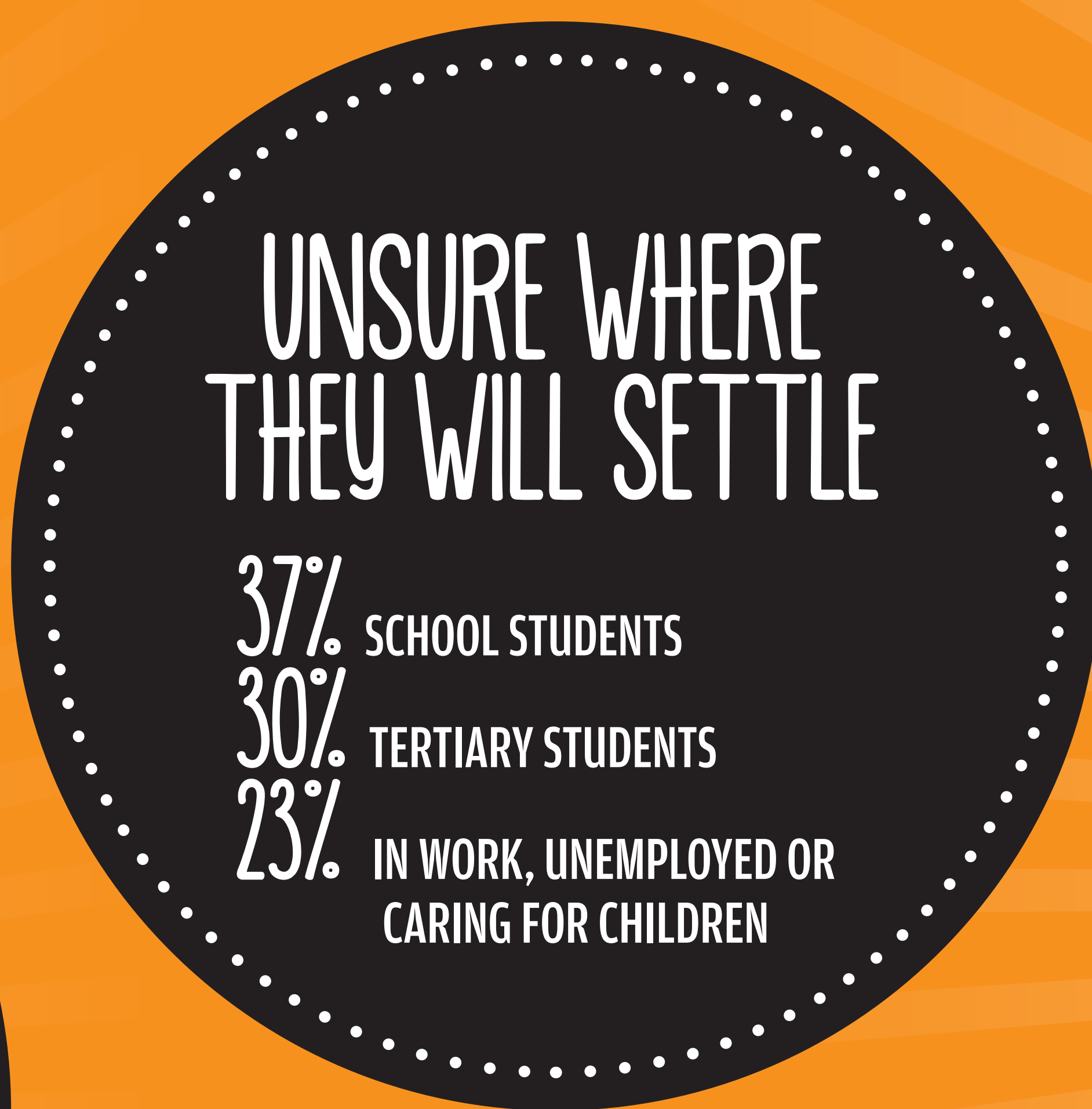
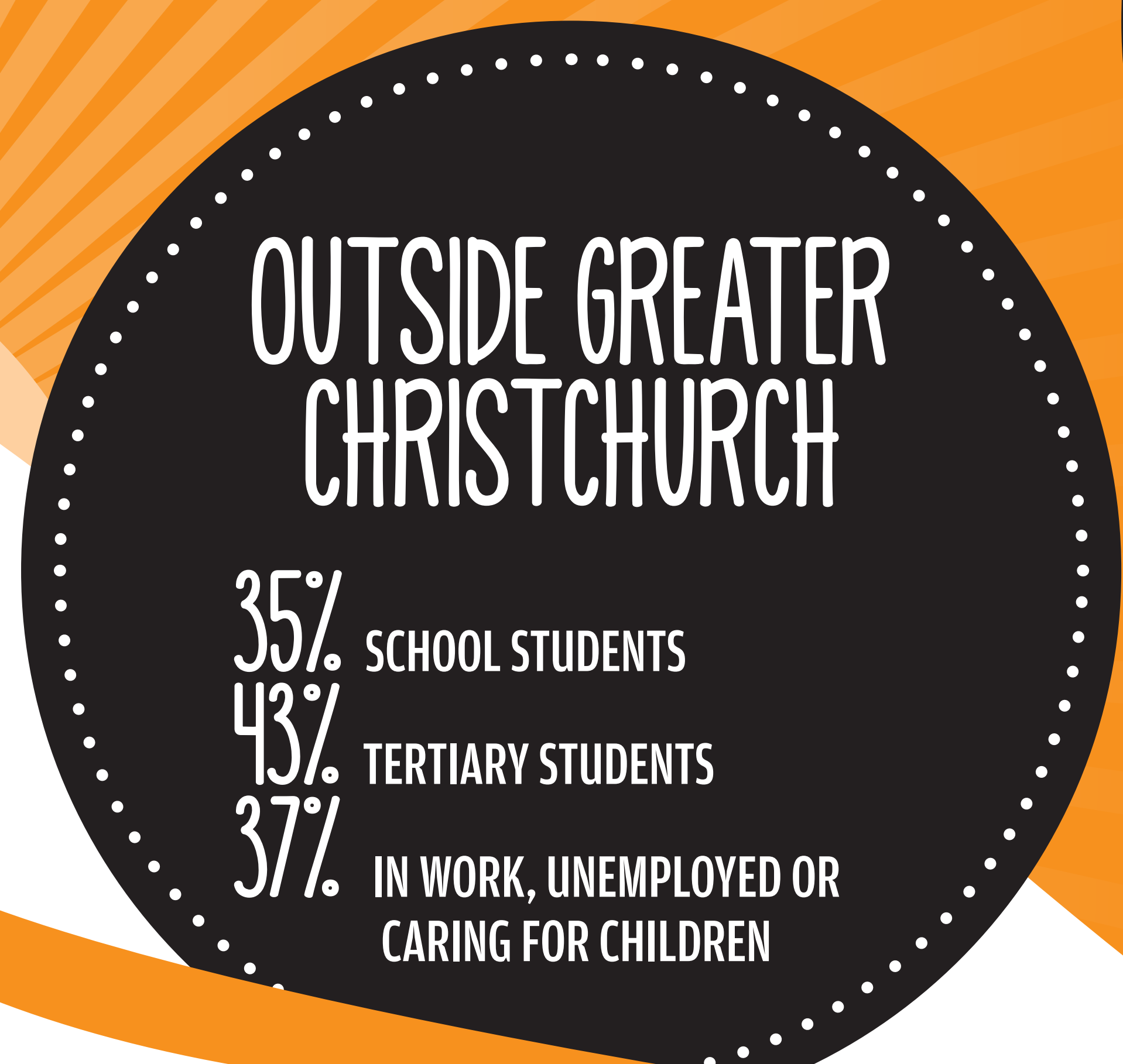

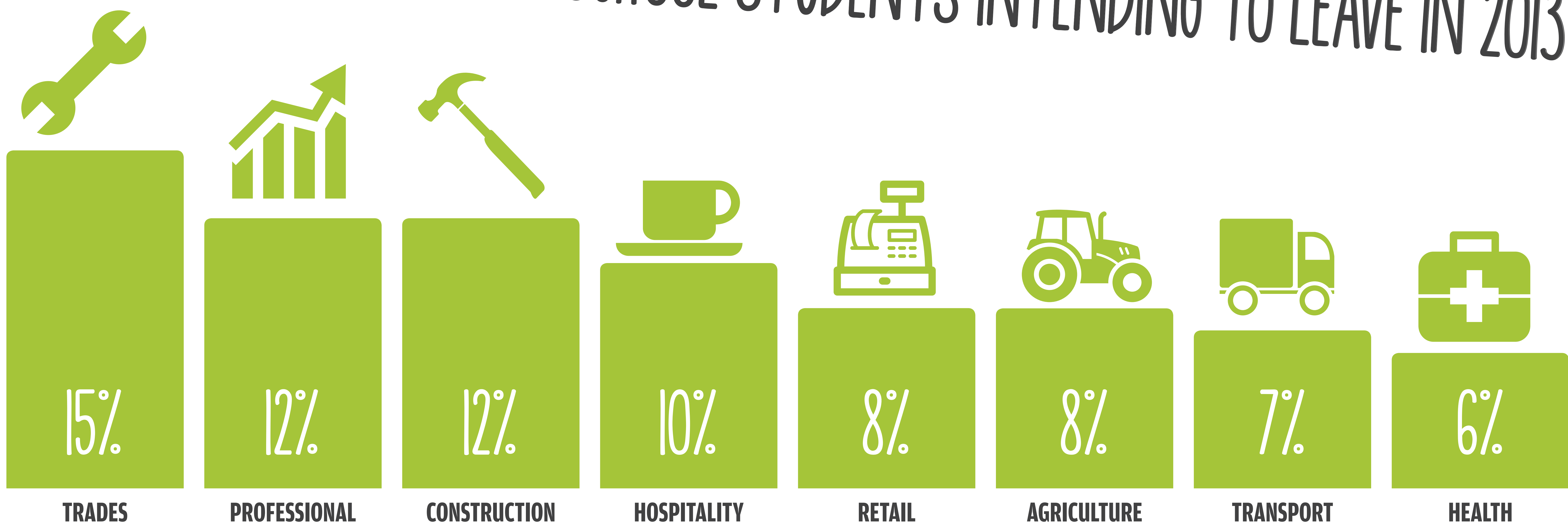

TYPES OF JOB SOUGHT BY SCHOOL STUDENTS INTENDING TO LEAVE IN 2013

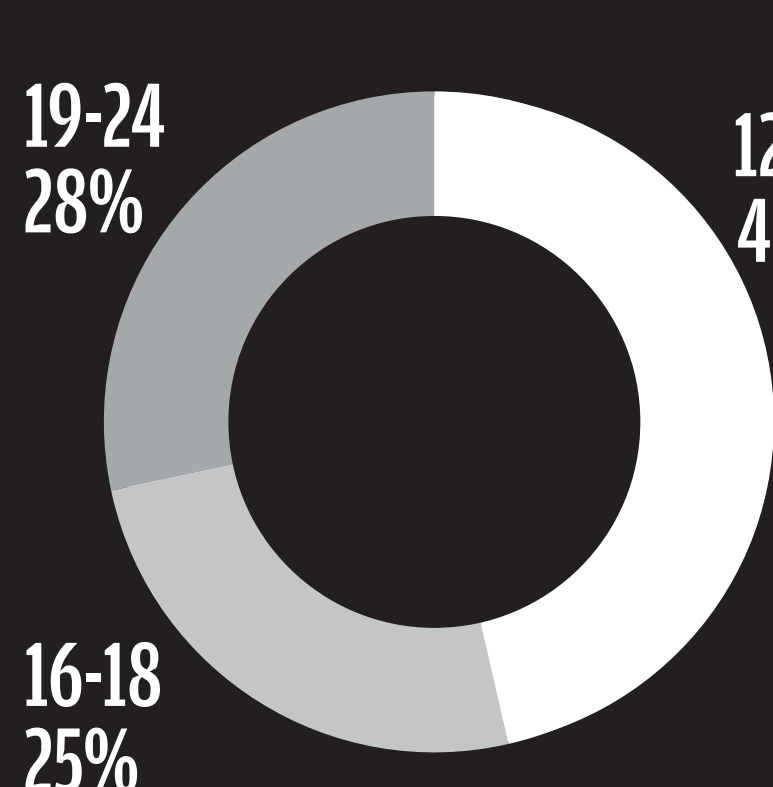

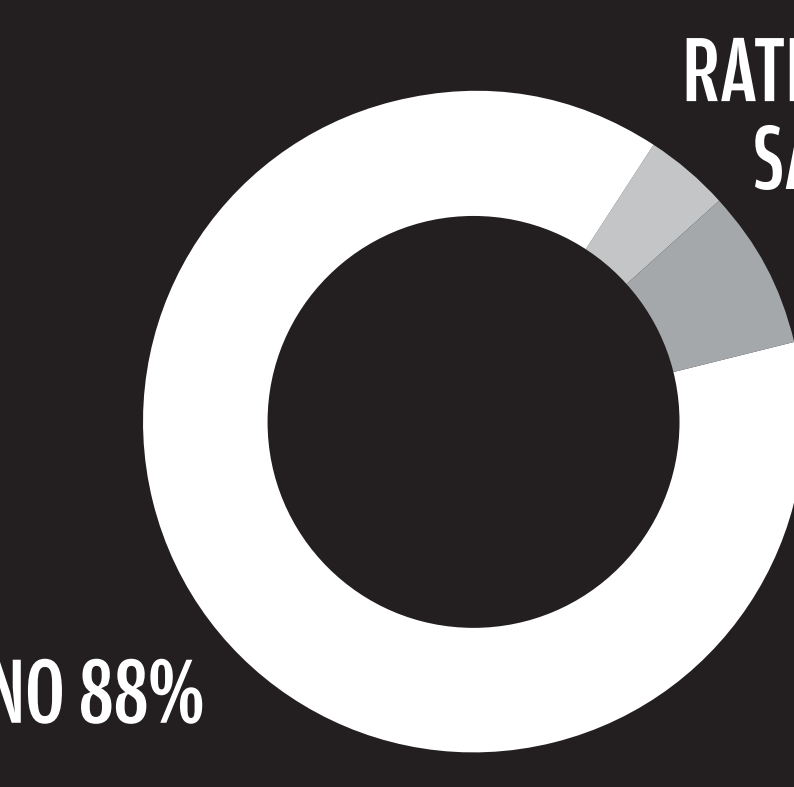

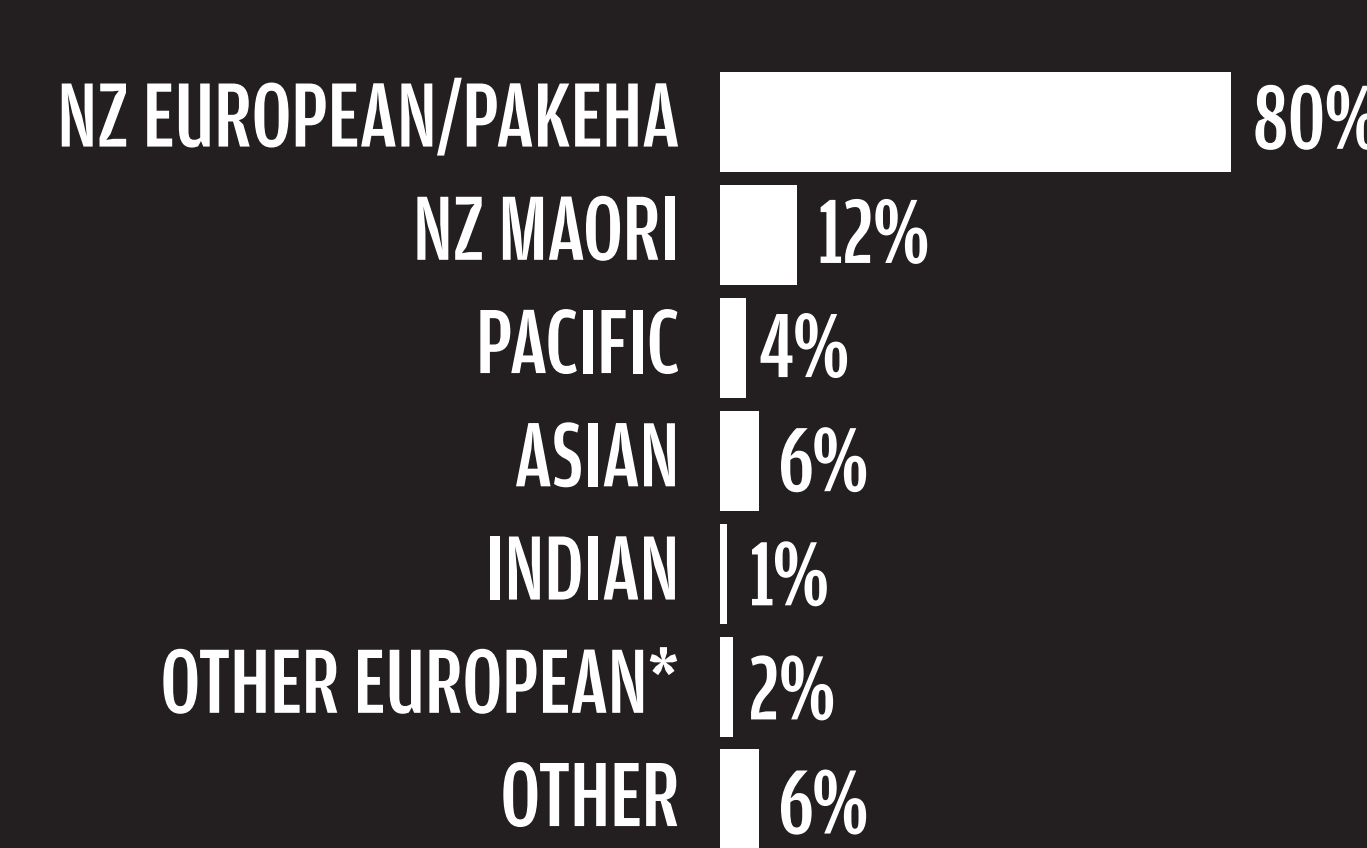

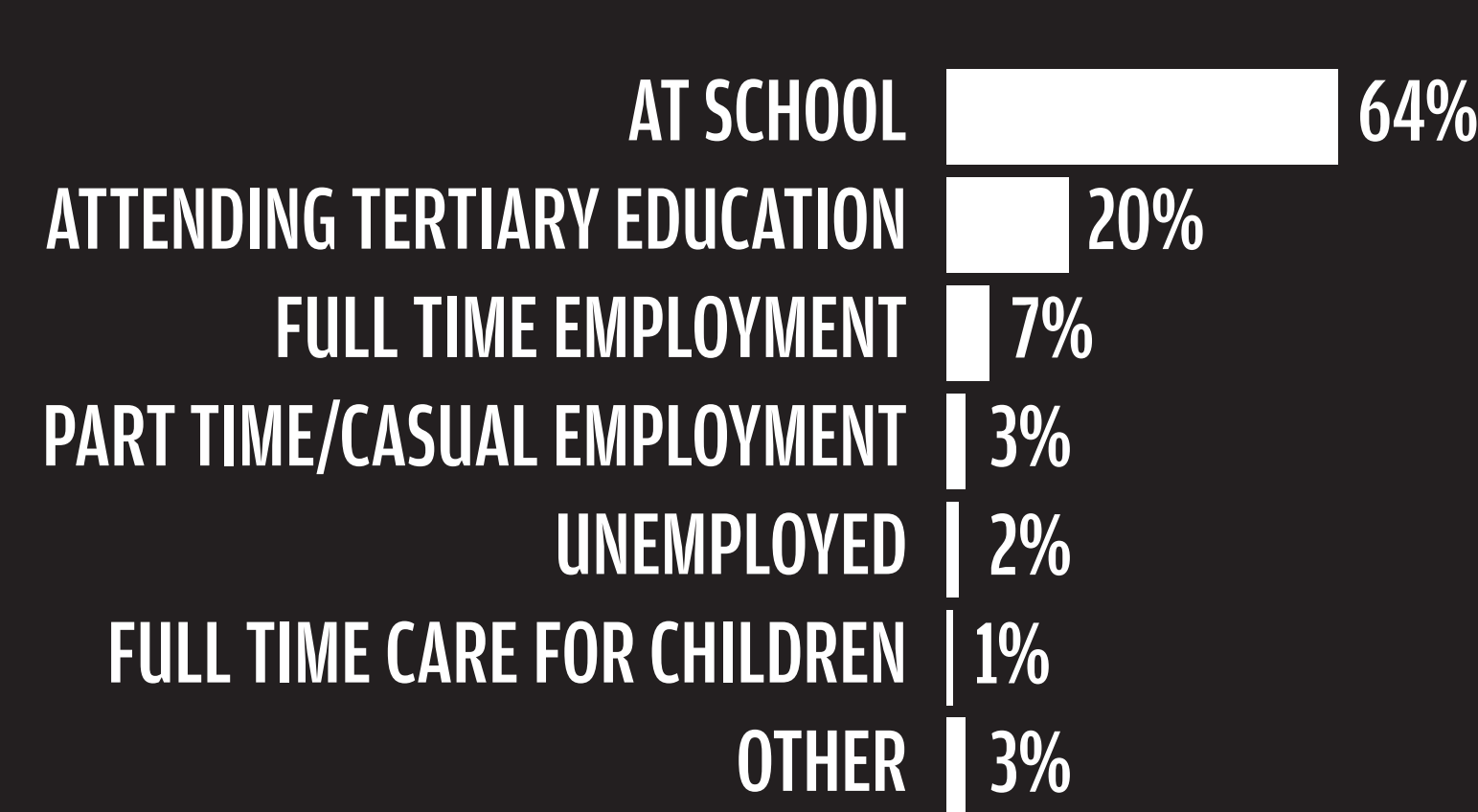
