Oral Item: Update on Matters Relating to Recent Weather Events

Portfolio Cyclone Recovery

On 27 February 2023, the Cabinet Extreme Weather Recovery Committee (EWR), exercising its Power to Act in accordance with its terms of reference:

- noted the updates provided by the regional Ministerial leads (Regional Ministers) on matters relating to the recent weather events, including updates from Hon Kelvin Davis (Northland), Hon Michael Wood (Auckland and Coromandel), Hon Kiri Allan (Tairāwhiti and Bay of Plenty), Hon Stuart Nash (Hawke's Bay) and Hon Kieran McAnulty (Tararua and Wairarapa);
- directed the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet to coordinate, with Regional Ministers, the preparation of a paper for consideration by EWR at its next meeting on Tuesday, 7 March 2023, on each Regional Minister's proposed regional structure, including advice on the administrative support that may be required in relation to each regional structure:
- invited the Minister of Transport to provide advice to EWR on the assessment of roading network requirements and proposed priorities for each region;
- authorised the Minister for Cyclone Recovery, the Minister for the Environment, the Minister for Emergency Management and the Minister Responsible for the Earthquake Commission, in consultation with other relevant Ministers and agencies, to make decisions if required before the next EWR meeting on issues relating to the clean-up and removal of silt;
- directed the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) to coordinate the preparation of a paper to EWR on 7 March 2023 on silt-related issues, which includes advice from Treasury, the Ministry for Primary Industries, the Ministry for the Environment, the Ministry of Health and NEMA as appropriate on:
 - 5.1 the implications from a science, research, and health perspective;
 - 5.2 advice on what needs to be done in the short-term (including indicative costs), and the proposed measures that could be undertaken over a medium and longer-term timeframe;

- **invited** the Associate Minister of Finance (Hon Michael Wood) to coordinate a report back to EWR on 7 March 2023 on issues relating to flood insurance, land rehabilitation and related decisions, including linkages with the Resource Management Act reform programme and the proposed sequencing of the various workstreams, in the context of the flooding and Cyclone Gabrielle;
- 7 **invited** the Minister for Emergency Management to provide an update to EWR on 7 March 2023 on legislative changes required for the response.
