

TARGET DELIVERY ACTIONS

The Government's attendance action plan was announced in April, with the development of the second phase of initiatives underway:

- Improving data a new online data dashboard was released in May that makes
 daily attendance data available to the public and parents. Cabinet agreed to
 mandatory daily reporting from Term 1, 2025.
- Supports and services reviews of existing attendance services are underway
 to better target attendance supports, including the Education Review Office
 review of supports and interventions, due in October.
- Schools design of a stepped attendance response to set out requirements and
 expectations for parents, schools, and the Ministry of Education at different
 stages of students' attendance. Policy work is underway to make attendance a
 strategic priority for school boards and have an attendance management plan.
- Parents changes are being made to the way prosecution mechanisms are
 operationalised to improve visibility and consistency in their use. Engagement
 with key stakeholders and the sector starts in September.
- Communities refreshed health guidance to reinforce the importance of school attendance was released in May. An attendance public information campaign started in May and a behaviour change campaign is being developed.
