Official Information Act request: Historical ministerial lists

Thank you for your Official Information Act request received on 15 August 2024. You requested:

"Under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA), can I please request a copy of every version of the Ministerial List held by the Cabinet Office or the DPMC from 2014 onwards? Could you also confirm whether the collection you have is a complete collection or if some versions are missing. My hope is to obtain a complete and accurate record of all changes to ministerial portfolio allocations between 2014 and the present date. You will see below that I informally requested this information back in May 2023. While I acknowledge that some versions of the Ministerial List are available on the Internet Archive system, there is no guarantee that this represents the complete collection (as the Internet Archive system only periodically takes a snapshot) and therefore I do not consider that it can be considered "publicly available" in terms of the OIA."

On 3 September the Cabinet Office contacted you to advise the requested ministerial lists could be provided, however, a significant number of lists were issued in the timeframe. The total number sits around 70 lists. As an alternative, we offered a series of tables complied for each administration tracking the information included in ministerial lists. Our view was that this format may be of more use to you.

In your response you indicated you would like to receive the tables in place of the lists. I note your response was subject to reviewing the material.

Accordingly, I have decided to release the tables recording ministerial appointments for the four administrations since 8 October 2014. Please find these attached. If upon reviewing these tables, you wish to receive to the ministerial lists instead, please let us know.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.

This response will be published on the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet's website during our regular publication cycle. Typically, information is released monthly, or as otherwise determined. Your personal information including name and contact details will be removed for publication.
