# Official Information Act request relating to various documents regarding the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request received on 27 January 2025. You requested:

Under the Official Information Act 1982 I request the following:

Copies of all correspondence, including letters and emails to or from Hon Mark Mitchell, since 27 November 2023, regarding the following:

- The impact, if any, of Budget 2024 allocation of funding to Geohazard Information Services GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre.
- The future operating capability of Geohazard Information Services GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre.
- Changes, if any, required to Geohazard Information Services GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre's operating capability due to the funding outlined in Budget 2024.

Copies of all briefings, memos, advice, reports, or any other documents, provided to or from Hon Mark Mitchell since 27 November 2023 regarding the following:

- The required budget for operating GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre on a per year basis.
- The suitability of Budget 2024's outlined financial allocation for Geohazard Information Services GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre.
- The impact, if any, of Budget 2024's outlined financial allocation for Geohazard Information Services GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre.
- The risk, if any, to Geohazard Information Services GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre's future operation functionality or service delivery following Budget 2024's financial allocation.
- Any services within Geohazard Information Services GeoNet, the National Seismic Hazard Model and the 24/7 National Geohazard Monitoring Centre that would be unable to function, or have reduced functionality, following Budget 2024's financial allocation.

Identified as in scope of your request are some briefings provided by the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE). I believe these briefings are more closely connected to the functions of MBIE. Accordingly, I have decided to partially transfer your

request as it relates to these briefings under section 14(b)(ii) of the Act. As it is already outside of the ten working day time limit for transferring a request, I have extended the time-limit available to make this transfer under section 15(A) of the Act. This extension is required because of the consultation needed to make a decision on your request.

The time frame for responding to your request was also extended under section 15A of the Act by 15 working days because it necessitated consultations to be undertaken before a decision could be made on the request. Following this extension, I am now in a position to respond.

### Information being released

I have decided to release the relevant parts of the documents listed below, subject to information being withheld as noted. The relevant grounds under the Act which information has been withheld are:

- s9(2)(a), to protect the privacy of individuals
- s9(2)(ba)(i), to protect the supply of similar information in the future
- s9(2)(f)(iv), to maintain the confidentiality of advice tendered by or to Ministers and officials
- s9(2)(g)(i), to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinion.

Kia ora Joe,

As per our discussion yesterday, Minister Mitchell has requested a meeting with senior MBIE and NEMA officials to better understand (particularly from MBIE) the status of GeoNet and associated funding decisions. Minister Mitchell has questions and concerns as the Minister for Emergency Management and Recovery, and as the appropriation Minister.

In particular, the Minister would like officials to provide answers in the meeting to his following questions:

- What are the overall implications of the Budget 24 decisions on GeoNet?
- What decisions have been made, if any, regarding the \$6 million funding for enhanced geohazards monitoring that I understand [based on a response to a media query provided by MBIE] is ringfenced for the NGMC?
- How are decisions being made on what is prioritised by GeoNet within the fiscal constraints and how am I being advised of this?
- Is the NGMC being impacted more than other services provided by GeoNet to other portfolios? If so why, given the funding should be
  ringfenced and the consequences are at an unacceptable level of risk to life safety? How am I being advised or consulted on these
  decisions?

A meeting has been booked for 9.00-9.45am on Wednesday 13 November in the Minister's office (4.3L Beehive). I'll send you a meeting invitation to pass along to MBIE attendees – can you please confirm who these will be once you know (and by Mon 11 Nov)?

Over to you as to whether you would like to provide any advice in writing, and to liaise with Harry (copied, and we have also discussed) about any expectations from Minister Collins' advisor wishes to sit in on the meeting.

Response to question below

The Minister of Finance had one question - How much less funding are we delivering vs GNS's expectation?

- Over the next 4 years (to 27/28) GNS requested a minimum of s9(2)(f)(iv) to maintain GeoNet and the National Seismic Hazard Model (NSHM) (with loss of cap talisation in play, detail below).
- GNS received through Budget 24 \$106.94m for the 4 year period s9(2)(ba)(i)

### s9(2)(f)(iv)

- If, for example, the shortfall is provided to maintain the level of funding at 24/25 \$9(2)(f)(iv) over the 4 year period to 27/28, total funding would be s9(2)(ba)(i), s9(2)(f)(iv) This example is without GNS's margin being applied or capitalisation impact accounted for (detail below)
- We are working with agencies and GNS to consider future work programmes. The proposed split between GeoNet 1912 (1912) and NSHM 1912 (1912) and will mean a small increase in GeoNet funding compared with 23/2/89(2)(ba)(0) though less than what they requested through Budget. Overall, we consider this is a good outcome for GeoNet for 24/25. NSHM will have a reduced programme of development.
- . GNS will be concerned about the shortfall being realised. MBIE SIT's expectation is that GNS works directly with users of those services to commission and cost them appropriately.

The Bid reflected a "maintain" option with no expansion of the sensor network to the Alpine Fault and Auckland volcanic fields. The funding numbers are the result of complex calculations.

The Bid also reflects that capex was included as far as possible as opex (as directed by Treasury as no Cabinet approved capex business plan was available). This had a s9(2)(ba)(i)

We are working with EQC to address the capital requirements for 24/25 and so expect to reduce the capitalisation/accounting impact.

The increasing funding profile reflects application proportionally of a 10% margin - fully applied in 27/28 to reflect full cost funding.

### s9(2)(f)(iv)

- agreed that the funding shortfall from 2025/26 will need to be sourced from entities who use specific Geohazard services;
- 33 noted that from 2025/26 the National Emergency Management Agency is expected to pay for a portion of the National Geohazard Monitoring Centre, and that the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment will need to source funding for a portion of the National Seismic Hazard Model;
- invited the Minister for Emergency Management and Recovery and the Minister of Science, Innovation and Technology to report back to Cabinet before Budget 2025 with finalised funding arrangements;

This results in a small increase in funding for GeoNet c.f. this year (\$25.4m = \$18.7m opex + \$6.7m capex) but is \$9(2)(ba)(i) than the scaled option sought.

We believe fo 24/25 this is a good outcome for GeoNet, maybe not as good for NSHM (but agencies believe this is a fair amount for a scaled back programme).

The ut year funding requires NEMA and MBIE-Building to help address the funding shortfall and possible cost pressure increases for out years respectively for part of GeoNet (24/7 monitoring centre -NGMC) and NSHM.



### Context for cover memo:

- You are meeting with senior officials from MBIE and NEMA to discuss the Budget initiative for geohazards funding (GeoNet and the National Seismic Hazard Model) and upcoming joint advice on sustainable funding options, including ongoing portfolio responsibility for GeoNet.
- Note that GeoNet is an initiative within GNS Science, a Crown Research Institute. It is a combination of infrastructure, datasets and capability which inform science research, the insurance and building sectors, emergency management and land information management.

GeoNet is currently "club funded" by a range of portfolios, including Science, Innovation and Technology, Emergency Management and EQC. The sustainable approach will ideally seek to simplify the investment approach, potentially by a single investor being responsible for investment in core infrastructure, with additional services being paid for by relevant agencies.

- Note that MBIE invests in a range of science infrastructure in its Strategic Science Investment Fund (Infrastructure) platform and is responsible for overseeing the performance of the Crown Research Institutes, including their financial sustainability.
- NEMA expects advice on portfolio responsibility must start with assessing the suitability of this platform in the Science, Innovation and Technology portfolio.
- Note that you have been asked to submit a Budget initiative to the Treasury on Friday 16 February however MBIE has not yet provided options or advice on which portfolio is best placed to take forward the investment.
- MBIE has advised you that they expect to provide joint (with NEMA) advice on sustainable arrangements for GeoNet by 12 March 2024. Officials are currently sharing their expectations for how to approach this advice.
